PAMP SA is the first, among accredited refiners, to manufacture minted gold bars that incorporate fashion- and pop culture-derived motifs on their reverse sides.

Known as “icOns” bars, the motifs illustrate a variety of skins: cobra, crocodile, stingray, leopard and zebra.

The bars, launched in gold (and silver) in 2009, are issued in three weights: 20 g, 10 g and 5 g. Gold purity: 99.99%.

They are sold through selected retailers and jewellery outlets in the USA, Canada, Germany, Poland, United Kingdom, Bulgaria, Ukraine, Dubai, Japan, Malaysia and Australia.

They are designed so they can also be worn as pendants.

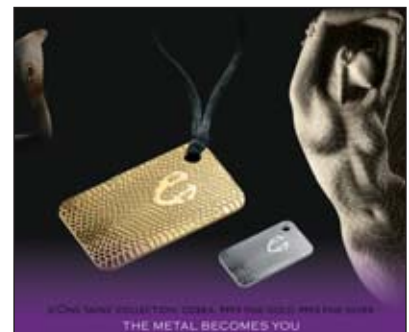


Illustrating the markings on the obverse side.

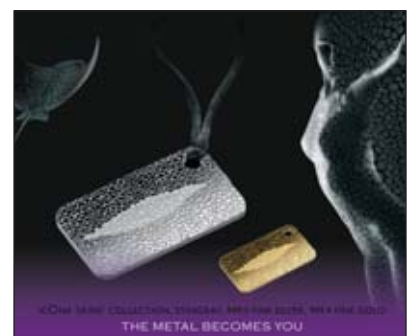


Crocodile

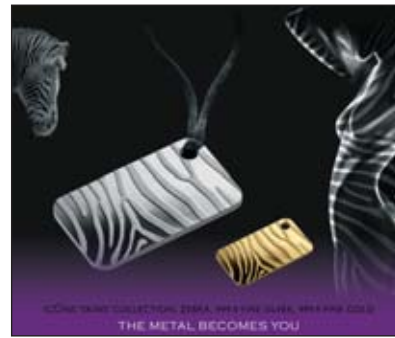


Stingray
